

6. Program

- In each category a set piece and a free choice must be played. They should differ in style and character.
- **Set piece for group I:** From the book *HERE AND NOW* published by Les Productions d'Oz (DZ 2451).
Set piece for group II: By Alexis Rago *AVANT L'AUBE*, published by Chanterelle by Zimmermann (ECH 765).
- A top performance of the set pieces is a pre-condition to qualify for a prize.
- You are advised to select pieces according to your technical abilities. The assessment will take into account the choice of program.
- The duration of the program group I: is 10 to 15 minutes.
The duration of the program group II: is 15 to 20 minutes.
- Participants, with the help of their teachers, are well advised to check the length of their programs. Anyone exceeding the allowed time will be asked to terminate their performance. (Total time includes tuning, etc.)

11th International Rago Competition at the Stuttgarter Musikschule Junior Guitar Solo

March 2nd 2019

A competition promoting the guitar compositions of the Venezuelan composer Alexis Rago will take place in Stuttgart for the 11th time on the 2nd of March 2019. This competition is organized and directed by the "Duo Montes-Kircher" and the "Stuttgarter Musikschule". This time the competition is for guitar solo and is open to competitors of all nationalities. There are two categories:

Group I (up to 15 years old): Must play one or more pieces from the book *HERE AND NOW* published by Les Productions d'Oz (DZ 2451) and free choice.

Group II (up to 18 years old): Must play by Alexis Rago *AVANT L'AUBE*, published by Chanterelle by Zimmermann (ECH 765) and free choice.

There must also be a free choice piece of contrasting style and character. The number of participants is limited and the final registration date is December 15th, 2018.
